

HESPERIA DAYS PARADE
ENTRY INFORMATION – KEEP FOR FUTURE REFERENCE
DO NOT RETURN WITH YOUR ENTRY

PARADE ROUTE

Parade starts promptly at 9:00 a.m.

- Parade check-in for general entries shall begin at 7:30 a.m. on the corner of Main Street and Peach Avenue in Hesperia.
- Parade check-in for Judged Equestrian Units begins at 7:30 a.m. at Timberlane Park – 3 blocks north of Main Street and Timberlane.
- Staging areas are located in residential areas - there must be NO LOUD NOISES before 8:00 a.m. The 1.2-mile parade route starts at Timberlane and Main Street.

Parade participants head west along Main Street to 'E' Avenue, turning right on 'E' Avenue to disband.

GENERAL RULES

All participants must be uniformed, costumed, or appropriately attired. Vehicles must be decorated, and may not reach a height of more than 13' 6". Lettering should be at least six inches tall for readability. Forward motion of the parade **MUST** be consistently maintained. Entry performances shall be limited to one minute in duration. Elected officials are welcome to ride as a dignitary.

- If an entrant is less than 18 years of age, a parent or guardian must sign the application.
- **Entrants agree to not throw, distribute, or spray anything along the parade route.**
- Entries expressing political or social views are strictly prohibited and will be denied parade entry. No space will be provided for candidates of an elected office.

AWARDS

JUDGED CLASSIFICATIONS shall be eligible for a Sweepstakes Trophy, Theme Trophy, and/or a First, Second, or Third Place Trophy. Awards shall be prejudged to all classifications listed in the Judged Classification section of the entry form. Judging for all Judged Classifications shall be done along the parade route while the parade is in process.

JUDGED EQUESTRIAN awards shall be determined by the California National Association of Paraders. Equestrian entries shall be eligible for First, Second and Third place in each classification; as well as the Presidents Trophy for best-mounted group and the Mayor's Trophy for best individual equestrian entry.

➤ **Equestrian pre-judging will take place at Timberlane Park between 7:30 a.m. and 8:30 a.m.**

- ❖ All award winners will be posted in the Daily Press.
- ❖ Trophies may be picked up at the Hesperia Recreation and Park District Office, 16292 Lime Street , Hesperia, beginning the Monday immediately following the day of the parade for ten business days.

All entries must include \$20.00 for each category entered, along with the entry form.
