B. Park Ranger Update

C. Lime Street Park Camera Update

- Cameras have been installed at Lime Street Park and are working well.

D. Maintenance Update on Current Projects

- Cleanup of brush and weeds is being done at Hesperia Lake Park in anticipation of trout season.
- Scaling and striping is complete at the Rick Novack Community Center, along with repairs to the ADA ramps.
- Bids are being accepted for the Park Center roof and are to be opened in the coming week.
- Looking at repairing the roof on the Program House at Lime Street Park.
- Fencing is up at Hesperia Civic Plaza Park for turf repair.
- 'C' Street property is being cleaned up to prepare for the Christmas tree.

- Percy Bakker Community Center has received a deep cleaning after a large amount of rentals.
- Renovation is being done on the softball fields at Timberlane Park.
- Working with the contractor on LMDs.

E. Hesperia Civic Plaza Park Maintenance Walk Through

- Grass has already begun to go dormant for winter.
- Graffiti is always an issue but staff continues to monitor and clean it.
- Focus has been given to edging and trimming.
- The wood chip filling is to be replenished.
- Discussion ensued on possibilities of conversion of the bocce ball court.
- Foliage around the park signs was suggested.
- Maintenance is planned for the area around the Christmas tree for the Christmas Tree Lighting Ceremony.
