RECREATION SERVICE PROVIDER
(Part Time/At-Will Position)

Definition

Under direction, the Recreation Service Provider shall perform a wide variety of duties involving the After School Activities Program (ASAP) and Kids Kamp Program.

Essential Functions

- Implementing and/or modifying recreational programs for the ASAP and Kids Kamp Program.
- Monitoring and supervising of program participants at the ASAP and Kids Kamp Program.
- Assist in the planning required for conducting assigned duties.
- Participate in various meetings for the purpose of sharing information and/or improving one's skills/knowledge.
- Perform record keeping and basic clerical functions, scheduling, copying, etc. for the purpose of supporting the ASAP and Kids Kamp program and maintaining program records.
- Perform light maintenance duties when needed.
- Occasionally assist in planning, organizing, and other duties related to special events.
- Inform supervisor of issues, updates, and other pertinent information in a timely manner.

Marginal Functions

- Assist other personnel, as needed, to support in the successful operation of the programs.
- Respond to emergency situations (e.g. injured participant, fights, etc.) to resolve immediate safety concerns.
- Will perform additional tasks as required and needed.

While performing any of the above duties, must be aware that he/she is acting as a representative of the District and must be public relations conscious.

This position is a part time position up to 19 hours per week.

- Must be available to work Monday through Friday, 12:00 to 6:30 p.m., for the ASAP program and 6:00 a.m. to 6:30 p.m. for Kids Kamp during school closures.
- Hours vary with programs, activities, and events scheduled or unscheduled.
- Possible days, nights, and weekend work will be required at different locations throughout the community.

Experience and Education Requirements

High School diploma or equivalent is required.

One year of related experience with young people of various ages and abilities is required.

Working Conditions

Environmental Conditions: Indoor and outdoor environment, exposure to possibly inclement weather conditions; exposed to products used for arts & crafts, glue, acrylic and watercolor paints, play-doh, clay; possible work around slippery and uneven surfaces; exposure to wind, dust, pollen, and bees.

Physical Conditions: Essential and marginal functions may require maintaining physical condition necessary for bending, stooping, kneeling, crawling, running, lifting; upper and lower body flexibility; standing or walking for prolonged periods of time; use of hands to finger, handle or feel objects; move rapidly to keep up with participants; hearing; clear speech; close and distance vision; mentally alert at all times.

Examination

All applicants will be screened and only those candidates who best match the needs of the District will be invited to compete further in the examination process.

Licensing, Certification, Testing Requirements

Must possess a valid California Driver License, and produce a DMV printout of driving record upon request. Take and pass a medical exam if requested. Undergo and clear fingerprinting and a background check as a prerequisite of employment. Undergo and pass or provide a current (within 4 years) TB Test clearance. Provide a valid CPR and First Aid Certification upon hire (no online certifications will be accepted).

Final Filing Date

Position open until filled. Prior to employment, the successful candidate shall be required to present documentation establishing identity and employment eligibility in accordance with the U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services.
