- Date of Fishing Report: **5/8/23** Report Completed By: **Anthony**
- Best Bait: Shrimp, Nightcrawlers, Mackerel
- Dates Covered in This Fishing Report: **5/1/23 – 5/8/23.**
- Weather conditions: Warm days (approx. 81-86°) and nice nights (approx. 53-60°). We've had many clear cool days, along with some windy days.
- Water Temperature: 63°, Water Level: 100% normal, Clarity: Cloudy.
- Last Stock: Catfish & Tilapia (**1,000 LBS** Catfish, **500 LBS** Tilapia): **Friday, 5/5/23**
- Next Stock: Catfish (**1,000 LBS**): **Thursday, 5/11/23**
- Hatchery: Pacific Aquafarms, Niland, CA (Catfish & Tilapia)
- Average Size: Most 1.5 – 2.5 pounds. Several caught were in the 3-4 LB range.
- Top Spots of the Week: North Shore, Grassy Bank
