Best Bait: Shrimp, Mackerel, and Nightcrawlers

Dates Covered on This Fishing Report: 7/3/23 – 7/18/23

Weather Conditions: Hot weather (approx. 85-101°) and cool nights (approx. 63-70°). We've had many clear days, along with some windy days.

Water Temperature: 78°, Water Level: 100% normal, Clarity: Cloudy

Last Stock: Catfish (1,000 LBS): Friday, 7/14/23

Next Stock: Catfish (1,000 LBS) and Tilapia (500 LBS): Friday, 7/21/23

Hatchery: Pacific Aquafarms, Niland, CA (Catfish & Tilapia)

Average Size: Most 2-3 pounds. Several caught were in the 6-10LB range.

Top Spots of the Week: North Shore, Finger Cove, and Grassy Bank

CATCHES OF THE WEEK:

Samuel Navarette, from San Bernardino, towed in this 8.5LB TANK of a catfish over on Grassy Bank, using mackerel.

Juan, from Pomona, pulled out a HUGE mudcat, weighing in at 7.94LB using shrimp on Sandy Point.

Robert Oiona, from Fontana, reeled in this BIG 7.7LB catfish using shrimp on North Shore.

John O'Brian, from Oak Hills, filled a stringer with 4 catfish, using shrimp on Sandy Point.

Alan Aguilar, from Apple Valley, landed a great-sized catfish, weighing 6.6LB on North Shore.
