#### DISCUSSION/ACTION ITEMS

- a. Review and Accept Nov 18<sup>th</sup>, 2022, Minutes
  - Motion by Jim, seconded by Lisa; accepted unanimously.
- b. Updates on Junior Historian Workbooks
  - Being presented all over and is posted on the Harrison Exhibit Center page on the District website.
  - It is used as a learning opportunity in some classes throughout the HUSD.Status Quo
- c. Update on Hesperia Trivia Card Game
  - Examples were shown. So far, there are a dozen made.
- d. Update on Geocaching Sites
  - There are two sites up and running, with two more on the way. The plan is to eventually have 20 sites, each with trivia cards.
- e. Moving Fence to Increase Outside Area by 288 Square Feet
  - The cost will be \$350 with free labor, and the movement will increase the size of the outside area creating more room for scale models.
  - Griz is hopeful that the non-profit grant from Home Depot will be funded
- f. Discussion on Fundraising Friends of the Hesperia Museum Fundraiser at the Museum with Outside Area

- Fundraiser to show off the elements of the museum and show progress, to inspire support from the community.
  - Perhaps at the end of May.
  - Brainstorming a bonus for donations. Have something to offer to inspire donations.
- g. Additional Agenda Items Next Meeting:
- Hoffman has brought up community service credits that would be available for HUSD students for helping out at the Museum as well as developing a list of perimeters on a document to show how their activities would earn them credits.
  - Possible activities would include tasks the students would like scanning documents, building, and repairing.
  - Tasks that would address all the domains of learning to inspire our students to adopt Hesperia and its history for their own.
  - Griz has permission to pull out a length of the original pipe that had been installed in 1912. That would be added to the length from 1914.
