- Best Bait: Minnows, Mini Jigs (Black, White, Pink), Nightcrawlers, Chartreuse PowerBait
- Dates Covered on This Fishing report: **3/6/23 – 3/16/23.**
- Weather Conditions: Cold Days (approx. 41-47°) and Chilly nights (approx. 32-36°). We've had many clear cool days, along with some rainy days.
- Water Temperature: 45°, Water Level: 100% normal, Clarity: Cloudy.
- Last Stock: Trout (**1,000 LBS**): **Thursday, 3/16/23**
