- e. Moving Fence to Increase Outside Area by 288 Square Feet
  - Griz reported that the expansion has been approved and is waiting for the material to be ordered.
- f. Discussion on Fundraising Friends of the Hesperia Museum Fundraiser at the Museum with Outside Area
  - Griz reported the location of the Fundraiser location has been changed to the Topsy Cactus Antique Mall on Walnut. The owner is donating the space for the event and has much better parking. Awaiting the agreement to be signed by The Topsy Cactus and District G.M. The fundraiser date is tentatively set for May 19<sup>th</sup>.
  - Regarding continued discussion on service credit for students at the museum, Jim stated that he is still gathering information and will report back.
- g. Additional Agenda Items for Next Meeting
  - Look at working with the City to fundraise to restore our first fire truck to a condition that it could be used in parades.
