- b. Update on Hesperia Trivia Card Game

- G. Drylie showed an example
- There are currently 28 trivia cards with more in the works
- Exploration of topics to expand to more cards-please suggest topics

c. Update on Geocaching Sites

- Currently there are 11 geocaching sites with a goal of 20
 - Walters Store
 - Hotel (Adventure Lab)
 - Schoolhouse
 - Museum
 - Golf Course
 - Monument on Arrowhead by yellow fencing
 - Other side of Deep Creep
 - Mariposa where rollers is
 - Miller's Crossing (Adventure Lab)
 - Lime Street Park
 - Hesperia Lake Park
- The sites have to be in excess of 535 feet of each other and some sites are too close
- Adventure Lab is another idea that doesn't use lock boxes like geocaches. It will use the perimeter of the GPS site and send you a question to which one would identify the space (such as a number on a sticker at the site)
 - This could be used to make the Fort Cajon site into an Adventure Lab site
- The sites are attracting about 30 visits a month
 - Griz gets emails when the sites are visited

d. Update on the Presentation Area

- Demo table, pipes, 2 cuts of 18" and 14" in a portable display
- Making steady progress
- Some equipment still needs removal

e. Recap on Museum Fundraiser (Held May 19, 2023)

- Generated about \$2400
