6	Hesperia's Original Water Source	Late 1880s	34°21'0.05"N	117°14'52.50"W	East Side of Lake Arrowhead Rd 2.3miles south of Hesperia Lake	The Flume was a 5 mile open Ditch that flowed from up in Deep Creek and then another 7 miles in an original 14" riveted Pipe and in 1912 it was upgraded to a 30" pipe.

8	Summit Valley Train Station	1880	34°19'30.40"N	117°25'15.93"W	The Station was Just North of the Railroad Tracks, About 2 miles west of 138 and Summit Valley Road	The Descanso was a converted Funeral Car that Chard Walker the Mail man and Telegraph operator lived in from the 1950s to 1960s . It is now restored to it original configuration and is at the Perris Valley Rail Road Museum
9	Elliot Ranch	1927	34°19'30.40"N	117°25'15.93"W	The Ranch is located south of the Marker in Little Horse Thief Canyon	
10	Miller's Corner	1920	34°25'34.40"N	117°23'1.97"W	The Marker is located on the Main St entrance to the Plaza on the west side of the road	Miller Corner was a landing strip for aircrafts. It was the last place to refuel before going down the Cajon and the First place coming up the Cajon

12	Original Water Supply Ditch (Hesperia's 1st Water source Reservoir)	Late 1880s	34°24'29.88"N	117°18'18.18"W	West Side of Hesperia Rd 1/4 mile north of Lime St.	The reservoir was operational up until the early 1960
13	Rolars "66" Gas Station	1941-1949	34°24'30.38"N	117°23'35.52"W	On the west side of Mariposa about a 1/2 mile north of Joshua	The actual site was on the East side of I-15 Just south of Joshua Lat 34°24'16.17"N Long 117°23'48.51"W
14	Mojave Indian Trail Hesperia Lake	Pre-Historic 1886	34°23'4.56"N	117°15'8.35"W	S/W Corner of Hesperia Lake at the Waterfall
